### 4. Eligibility

- Doctoral degree conferred within the last 10 years, or an equivalent research career (including equivalent degrees such as a PhD from an overseas university)
- Under 40 years old by the deadline of this open call
- Fluent in English and able to give lectures and research guidance in English
- Able to start no later than March 1, 2018

At Hokkaido University, we are actively promoting both education and research activities while relying on diverse human resources and gender-equality. Therefore, we explicitly invite women qualified in research field to apply.

### 5. Employment Conditions

- (1) Employed as a fixed-term Tenure-Track Assistant Professor from Fiscal Year 2017 until March 31, 2022.

(2) A mid-term performance evaluation will be held in FY2019. The final tenure review (for tenured assistant professor) will be held by the end of the contract period. In the event that the achievements of the tenure-track assistant professor are superior, the final tenure review may be made ahead of schedule in FY2019 or in FY2020.

(3) Salary: Based on the rules and regulations of Hokkaido University (from 500,000 yen to 540,000 yen per month).

(4) Research Environment

- The research fund for the initial two years will be subsidized by the Tenure-Track System Promotion Program—two million yen in total for two years

- Research space: Research office in the faculty

- Peer-reviewed and published research papers
- Presentations (including oral presentations) given within Japan and abroad
- Experience/engagement in the promotion of interdisciplinary/international research (planning and hosting international symposia, participation in international collaborative research, and so on)

2. Educational Activities

- Teaching experience in general education and the hosting department
- Research guidance for undergraduate and graduate students in the hosting department
- Participation on a doctoral thesis review committee

3. Management and Leadership Skills

- Creation of a research plan and experience building a research system
- Active networking for research
- Degree of engagement in outreach and publicity activities
- Experience in planning and promoting symposia
- Degree of engagement in the university's administration and projects
- Research grants awarded
- Research ethics and risk management
