We invite applications for a faculty position at Lecturer or Assistant Professor level in the Institute of Seismology and Volcanology, Faculty of Science, Hokkaido University as follows. 3. Field of Research and Scope of Work

We are seeking an individual with demonstrated potential to promote researches in ocean bottom seismology and tsunami for disaster mitigation based on geophysical observations, numerical simulations and field surveys. She/He is expected to collaborate with other colleagues in our university for sea-going fieldwork such as ocean-bottom seismology surveys. She/He will belong to the Faculty of Science and engage in educational, administrative and managing activities in the Division of Seismology and Volcanology, Department of Natural History of Sciences, Graduate School of Science, and in the Department of Earth and Planetary Sciences, School of Science. She/He is expected to teach courses in the above-mentioned schools and General Education, and participate social action activities including disaster mitigation measures by national and local governments and outreach activities.

4. Qualifications

The qualified candidates must hold or expected to hold a doctorate at the time of recruitment. The candidates should have a good command of Japanese language for communicating with other faculty members, students, municipalities and citizens. The candidates should have an ordinary driver's license or expected to obtain it by the time of hiring.
